It is imperative that we leave at 8:30 for a timely arrival at the Blackbird Airpark as they will be opening early just for us.

From northbound 405: Exit at Burbank Blvd. and head west. Go to Woodley Avenue and turn right (north). Follow Woodley Avenue to Victory Blvd. Woodley Avenue Park is on the SE corner of Woodley Ave. and Victory Blvd.

From southbound 405: Exit at Victory Blvd. and head west. Turn left (south) at Woodley Avenue. Woodley Avenue Park is on the SE corner of Woodley Ave. and Victory Blvd.
