When a Crate Engine is correctly and completely installed, ROUSH will cover defects, subject to the exclusions and limitations identified in this warranty, in our materials and workmanship during the Warranty Period, as solely determined by us. ROUSH warranty coverage provisions as follows:

-Engine repairs totaling \$499 or less (based on the total repair estimate) will be reviewed by the ROUSH corporate office. If approved, a ROUSH approved repair facility will be authorized to complete these repairs. Any repairs costs exceeding \$499 for completed repairs at a facility other than the ROUSH build facility in Livonia, Michigan will be the sole responsibility of the customer.

-Engine repairs totaling \$500 or greater (based on the total repair estimate) will be reviewed by the ROUSH corporate office. - To obtain warranty service on your vehicle upfitted with the Crate Engine, the vehicle must have oil changes performed at the intervals of every 6 months or 3000 miles, whichever occurs first, either at a dealership or commercial maintenance center. You are responsible for providing ROUSH with proof of proper maintenance when you request any repairs under this warranty.

NOTE: Your failure to call ROUSH and receive authorization before any repair work is performed will invalidate your claim. ROUSH may reject your shipment if you fail to contact us and receive authorization before shipment of your Crate Engine or covered component.

Our Performance Policy

When you purchase a ROUSH Crate Engine, you're protected by our Performance Policy. ROUSH stands behind its Crate Engines. This policy is limited to the original owner of the vehicle in which the Crate Engine is installed and is not transferable to a second owner.

Our Performance Policy Period

The Policy Period for the Crate Engine is 2 years or 24,000 miles from either the original in-service date (subject to ROUSH's verification) of the Crate Engine as determined by the installation date shown on your service installation receipt, -OR- 90 days from the purchase date from ROUSH of the Crate Engine as shown on your ROUSH Invoice -or- ROUSH shipping Bill of Lading evidencing the proof of purchase date, whichever date is first.

Our Performance Policy Coverage

When the Crate Engine is correctly and completely installed, ROUSH will provide to you, the original owner of the vehicle in which the Crate Engine was installed, limited service and parts (as identified below) for defects in the material or workmanship found in your Crate Engine.

Roush's total liability to you under this Policy for a covered Crate Engine is limited solely to 40% of the original price you paid for the Crate Engine.

We will address the situation professionally and promptly, but you must follow this Policy in a timely manner as described below. Note, this Policy does not include the cost of removal or reinstallation, shipment to and from ROUSH of the Crate Engine or covered component or repair costs incurred from a service facility other than ROUSH, and does not apply for the reasons identified in the "Disclaimer" below. ROUSH reserves the right to deny coverage under this Policy.

Below are those components covered and not covered under this policy:

ENGINE COMPONENTS

COVERED: engine block and cylinder heads, all internally lubricated parts of the engine, including pistons, piston rings, piston pins, crankshaft and main bearings, connecting rods and bearings, camshafts and camshaft bearings, timing chain and gears, intake and exhaust valves and seals, valve springs, oil pump, push rods, rocker arms, fuel injection components, valve stem seals and hydraulic lifters, to the extent that the original engine contains the referenced warranted part. Parts that require normal manufacturers recommended replacement intervals are not covered.

NOT COVERED: Those engine components specifically not listed including, but not limited to, parts, air filters, oil filters, clutch disc, water pump, pressure plate, etc., that are required to be replaced as a part of a normal vehicle maintenance schedule are not covered.

***Alternators, Starters, Distributors, Water Pumps and Carburetors** are separately warranted by the component manufacturer. ANY ENGINE, WHICH HAS BEEN IMPROPERLY INSTALLED OR FAILS BECAUSE OF DEFECTS OF INEFFICIENCY OF PARTS OR UNITS NOT FURNISHED WITH THE ENGINE, ABUSE, ALTERATION, IMPROPER USE, NEGLIGENCE, OR DAMAGE AS A RESULT OF OVERHEATING, LACK OF MAINTENANCE, FUEL CONTAMINATION, LACK OF LUBRICATION, OR DAMAGE RESULTING FROM A COLLISION. - h. THE USE OF NON-ROUSH ACCESSORIES INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, CAMSHAFTS, SUPERCHARGER, TURBOCHARGER, NITROUS OXIDE SYSTEMS AND OTHER AFTERMARKET PRODUCTS INCLUDING OCTANE BOOSTERS.

NOTE: Your failure to call ROUSH and receive authorization before any repair work is performed will invalidate your claim. ROUSH may reject your shipment if you fail to contact us and receive authorization before shipment of your Crate Engine or covered component.

- Present us with a valid, properly documented claim during the Policy Coverage, we will, at our option and sole discretion, repair or replace the defective component(s) covered by this Policy. Anything we replace under this Policy becomes the property of ROUSH. Any component(s) we replace under this Policy will be considered part of the original Crate Engine and will assume the remaining Policy Coverage for the Crate Engine.
- Removal of the crate engine, proper crating of the engine and reinstallation of the engine once returned will be the sole responsibility of the customer. You are solely responsible for all costs to

ship the Crate Engine or any component to and from ROUSH. ROUSH will not reimburse you for any of these costs.
